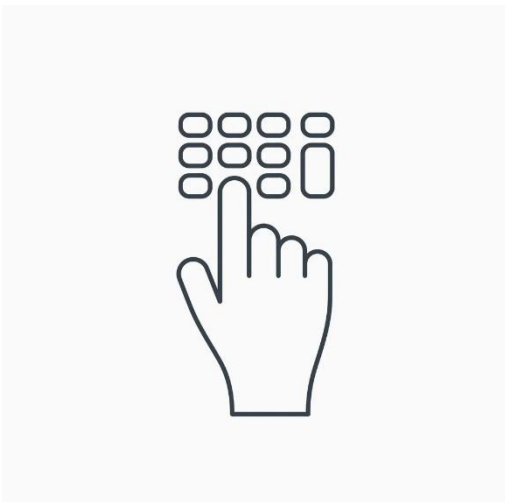


## Refunds
